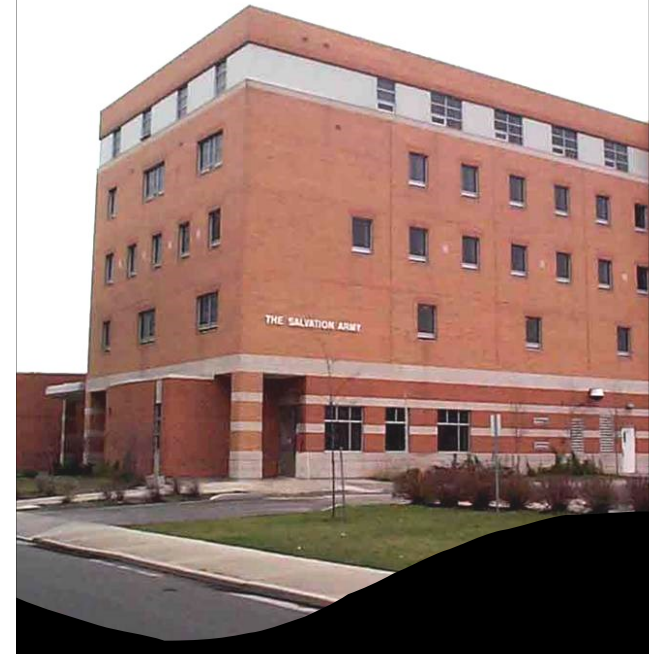
MISSION STATEMENT

OUR SERVICES

Emergency Shelter:

We provide overnight shelter for homeless men aged 16 and older on a short term, emergency basis. Operating under the Housing First model, our onsite Social Workers assist clients in securing permanent housing, provide follow-up assistance, and assist in setting up supports and resources to make their house a home.

Community Care Centre: Housing with Supports

We provide longer term accommodations to those needing assistance who have had a breakdown in their community-based living and may require support in dealing with their mental health or other concerns. Our Housing With Supports promotes hope in a supportive, compassionate environment.

Spiritual Care and Chaplaincy Services:



We provide spiritual support to those who seek it. Our on-site chaplain is available to meet with anyone interested in improving their spiritual health and well-being.

Chapel Services are held regularly

Mondays 4 pm

All are welcome to worship with us.



Food Bank: Open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 12:30 PM - 3:30 PM

We provide basic needs of food, household items and clothing for low income individuals and families. People who use our food bank are given the opportunity to make their own food choices.

Community Programs:

Cooking Skills - registered 18 hours over 9 month program to learn food handling and preparation, demonstrate cooking skills and receive Safe Food Handler's Certificate.

Sewing Skills - registered 18 hour over 9 month program. Learn how to read and cut patterns, alter, sew and mend clothing. An opportunity to experience practical placement.

Wholeness and Wellness - participants will learn Yoga and Zumba techniques, increase awareness on mental health and emotional health and share in our community circle.

Cooking around the World - Get a taste of Windsor's cultural diversity at Windsor Centre of Hope while building your social network.

Community Meal:

Our community meal is available 12 months of the year every **Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 5:30 pm to 6:30 pm** providing an evening meal with soup/salad, entrée, dessert, tea/coffee, to individuals
