<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participate in development and implementation of resident case plans • Report to program Manager progress, changes and / or regression in the resident's status • Within the resident's existing environment encourage, where applicable, positive life-style alternatives: socialization, grooming and hygiene, external social opportunities, respect for dignity of themselves and others, support resident ownership of own actions and problem solving • Help residents develop problem solving and coping skills • Maintain accurate records of resident stays on paper and/or computer • Monitor basic medical care, handle out and ordering of medications, record medication on eMAR system • Ensure that fire safety and public health standard care is maintained • Identify severe dysfunctional behaviors i.e. substance abuse, etc. and consult program Manager • Plan and implement a meaningful activity, held at WCOH • Responsible for keeping the floor and resident's room clean • Available for other duties as assigned by Manager
