## OUR SERVICES

### PATHWAY OF HOPE

Pathway of Hope provides support for individuals and family through an intensive support system helping them raise their standard of living by connecting them to services that are available within our community while walking alongside them as they map out their journey of success. It enables a network of support; a sense of community; holistic programs and spiritual guidance.

### HOUSING WITH SUPPORTS

We provide longer term accommodations to those needing assistance who have had a breakdown in their community-based living and may require support in dealing with their mental health or other concerns. Our Housing with Supports promotes hope in a supportive, compassionate environment.

### SPIRITUAL CARE & CHAPLAINCY SERVICES

We provide spiritual support to those who seek it. Our on-site chaplain is available to meet with anyone interested in improving their spiritual health and well-being. There are a variety of group and one-on-one services available.

### THE LEARNING CORNER CHILD CARE

The Learning Corner is a 90-space licensed childcare facility. We care for the children's physical, social, emotional, spiritual and intellectual development.

### FOOD BANK HOURS

*Mon, Wed, & Thurs*  
**11:30am - 3:30pm**



We provide basic needs of food, household items and clothing for low-income individuals and families. People who use our food bank are given the opportunity to make their own food choices

### SOAP WITH HOPE

The shower program is open weekly from Mondays to Fridays between 9:30am to 11:00am and available to both men and women in the community. Access is made on an appointment basis of first come, first served. The program provides shower facilities, towels, toiletries, and basic clothing items on a needs basis.

### COMMUNITY MEAL

The Community Meal program is every Thursday 6-7pm at the Centre of Hope. The meal provides an opportunity for members of the community to come and share food and fellowship. The meal consists of soup/salad, entrée, dessert, tea/coffee, to individuals and families.

### CHRISTMAS ASSISTANCE

#### Toys & Food

We provide toys for children and food for families during the Christmas Season.

#### Annual Christmas Dinner Celebration

We host an annual free Community Christmas dinner in partnership with St. Clair Centre for the Arts.

#### Christmas Kettle Campaign

Our Christmas Kettle Campaign donations assist us in providing programs and food for those who need support in the city of Windsor.



#### EMERGENCY SHELTER

We provide 32 overnight shelter beds for homeless men aged 16 and older on a short term, emergency basis. Our onsite Social Workers assist clients in securing permanent housing, provide follow-up assistance, and assist in setting up supports and resources to make their house a home.
